**Scoring Notes:**

2. Judges are responsible for ensuring the authenticity and fairness of their review comments.

3. For the final round, the highest and lowest scores will be excluded, and the average of the remaining scores will be taken as the final score for the oral presentation and defense. In the event of a tie, the judge panel will deliberate and make a final decision.

4. Final Score = Final Round Score (30%) + Preliminary Round Score (70%), with precision to two decimal places.
